

## **Child Pedestrians**

The reduction in child pedestrian killed and seriously injured casualties in London is greater than the national reduction when compared to the 1994-98 average. (Greater London -71% by 2009, GB -60% by 2009).

We believe, in line with the government Child Pedestrian Strategy, that drivers have the biggest part to play in reducing child pedestrian casualties.

However, we also feel that parents, schools and local authorities have a key role to play in providing road safety education and practical pedestrian skills training to children.

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
