

## **Double British Summer Time**

Government research (Broughton and Sedman, “The Potential Effects on Road Casualties of Double British Summer Time”, TRRL 228) indicates that moving to Double British Summer Time could save around 450 deaths and serious injuries on the roads per year, including between 104 to 138 fatalities.

We encourage the Government to run a pilot or trial to gauge the effects of making this move on a permanent basis.
