

Drug Driving

We are concerned that driving whilst impaired by drugs (illicit, prescribed and over the counter preparations) is a growing problem.

The government should continue to research the scope of the problem.

The Government and police should continue to trial roadside drug testing equipment to use alongside the Field Impairment Tests which are currently used.

We encourage the government to implement a traffic light labelling system for prescription drugs and over-the-counter preparations. A red label for drugs that will impair driving ability, an amber label for those that could impair driving ability given certain conditions and a green label for those drugs that have no detrimental effect on driving ability.
