

In Car Safety

The law requires vehicle occupants to wear seat belts and children to use the correct restraint for their weight and height until they reach their 12th birthday or 135cms in height.

We encourage the police to actively enforce this requirement.

Research has shown that many child car seats are incorrectly fitted or can be incompatible with some vehicles. Work should be done to raise the profile of this issue.
